TO SANTA VITTORIA BEATS THE HEART OF TWO EU-FUNDED PROJECTS

In Lisbon it was concluded the European project "Becoming Better Through Collaboration" (first results available on the website www.bbtcgrundtvig.com) and the training agency consortium CESAF S.c., Santa Vittoria d'Alba, the Italian partner, it is already in full operation on two new projects funded by the European Community.

UNI-KEY and MILLA are acronyms for identification of new works where CESAF in the first case is partner (the coordinator is the Hochschule Fulda-University of Applied Sciences of Fulda in Germany) while in the second case is the author of the project.

The objective of UNI-KEY (www.uni-key.eu) financed by "Lifelong Learning Programme – Erasmus" is to develop the entrepreneurial spirit in students, subjects of European mobility, on the model of Erasmus and Leonardo. To the first meeting held in Fulda on 13-16 November, the 10 partners (9 European and 1 from South Africa) have laid the groundwork and planned the work of the next two years.

By December 2013, the date when ends the project, the aim is to create a computing platform and a network of contacts between students and companies in order to improve the transition of students from being active in European mobility to successful entrepreneurs.

Each partner is responsible for a Work Package, which is a part of the project, but everything is coordinated by the University of Fulda which will remain in close contact with all partners through media informatics, until the next meeting scheduled in Brussels at the end of March 2012.

"Grundtvig" is the platform of European contributions that approved the project MILLA (acronym for MIgrant Language Learning At workplace) where the CESAF Consortium is creator and coordinator. The goal of this work is to identify new methods of teaching and incentive training paying special attention to migrant workers who have to learn the local language at the workplace. The project leader of the Italian team is Franco Tibaldi, responsible for the training activities of the Consortium, Santa Vittoria d'Alba Office, from 2002.

The first European Grundtvig project "Becoming Better Through Collaboration" in which CESAF participated, Tibaldi explains that it began in 2009 with the "kick-off metting" in Girona, Spain. It was a rich and exciting adventure that saw us together for the last time with the other five partners (i.e. schools/training agencies from Spain, Portugal, Turkey, Romania and Greece) in Lisbon, then it was concluded in September 2011 through the latest electronic methods and the online publication of the results.

The next projects says Tibaldi, are a source of pride for the ambitious targets that have been scheduled in early 2011. In particular for MILLA, as project writer and leader of the partnership, we are already working to provide the initial results of an intensive collaborative work, started from the very first meeting in Rejkyavik - Iceland held in November 18-23, 2011.
